UCSD LIONTREE ARENA

Team Member/Public Access:

Access the UCSD LionTree Arena through the main entrance located off of Ridge Walk pathway, which is easily accessible from the Hopkins parking Structure.

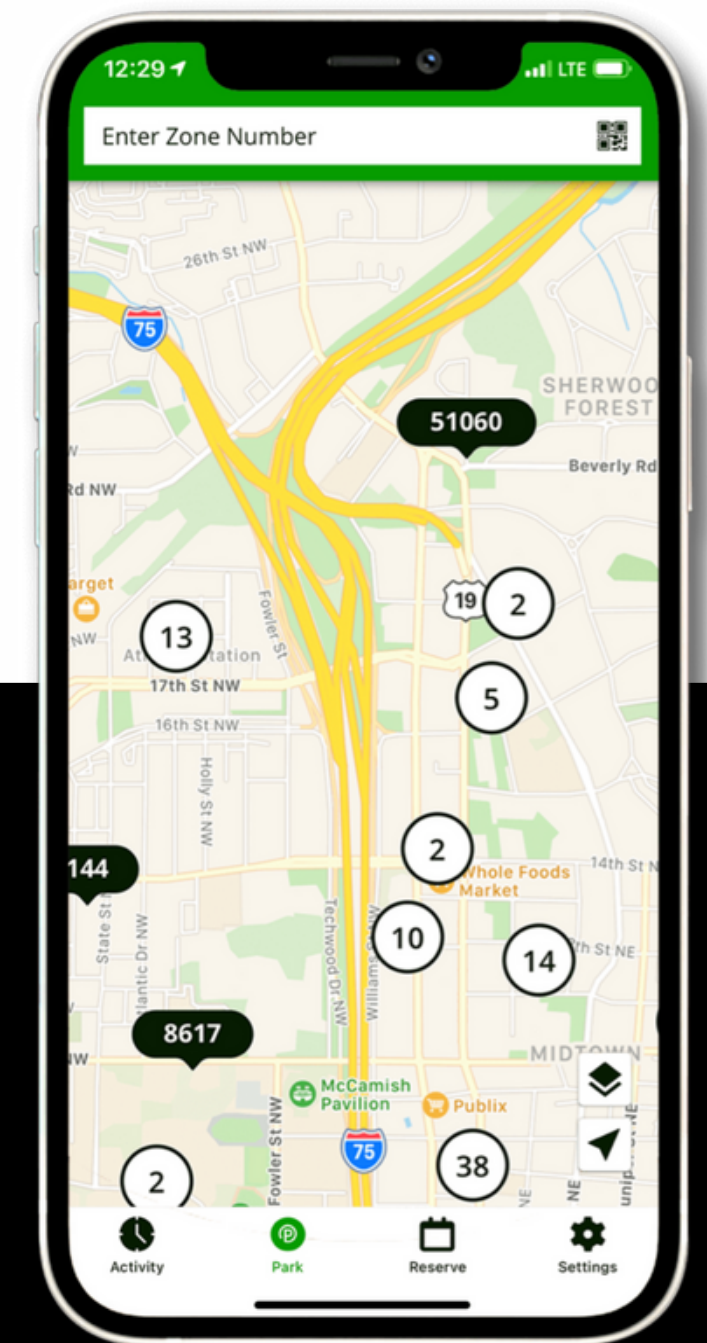


PARKING

HOPKINS PARKING STRUCTURE

- UCSD Hopkins Parking Structure
- We have secured a special parking rate of \$4/day
- Only parking in spots labeled of B, S & V
- Must be paid for using the ParkMobile app
- Download app and set-up before you arrive

- See email for detailed instructions and the **Special Zone Code**

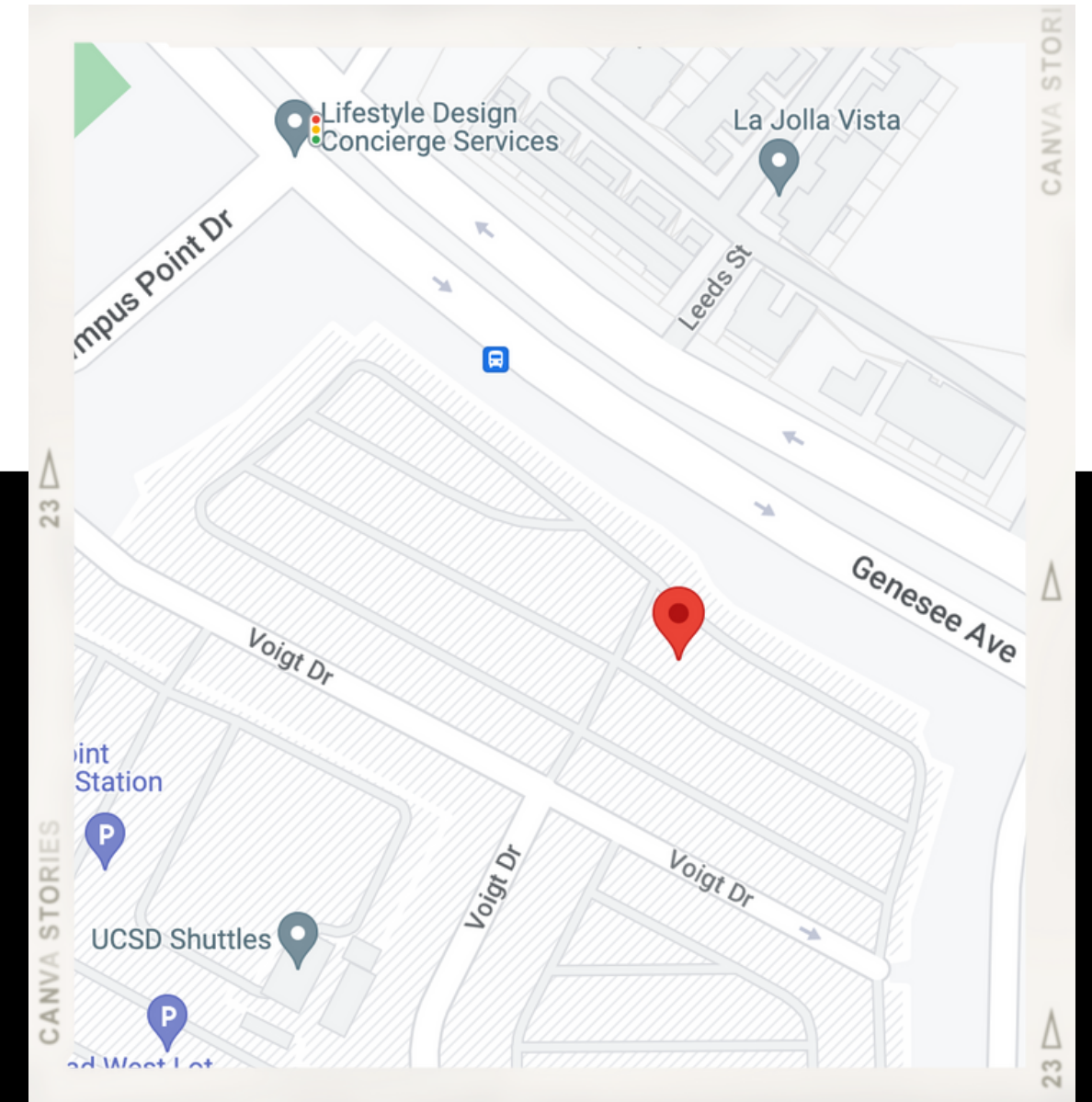


- Overflow parking is available in the Pangea Parking Structure (5-10 min walk to the arena)

OVERSIZED PARKING

REGENTS ROAD NORTHEAST LOT

- In UCSD's remote parking lot at the corner of Voigt Dr. and Campus Point Drive
- No oversized or overnight parking is available on campus.
- Parking is free
- The lot is not really walkable from the venue (30 minute walk).
- There is no security



LOAD-IN

THURSDAY & FRIDAY

Active Load In Times:

- Thursday, 3/23, 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM
- Friday, 3/24, 7:45 AM to 8:30 AM

Key points:

- Teams **must queue in a remote area** prior to being allowed into the arena loading area.
- **Large trailers are discouraged.** The arena loading area is very tight.





HOURS TO ARRIVE IN THE QUEUE AREA

- Thursday: 4:00pm – 7:45pm
- Friday: 7:15am – 8:15am

Load-in Procedure:

- Drive to the queue area located at Northpoint Lane parking loop (lot P359)
- Check in with volunteers
- Driver must stay with vehicle at all times
- Once at the front of the line, a volunteer will allow you to depart to the arena loading area by providing you a **LOADING PASS**
- Drive to Arena Loading Area at the arena
- Check in with Volunteer upon arrival
- Unload vehicle
- Depart the load in area immediately after your vehicle is unloaded

LOAD-OUT

DIFFERENT PROCEDURE THAN LOAD-IN

LOAD OUT TIME:

- Sunday, 3/26, 1:00pm – 6:00pm

There will be no queue area volunteer for load out.

Key points

- Team's load out vehicle/s must queue in the remote area prior to being allowed in the arena loading area
- You be turned away at the arena loading area if they do not have a **LOAD OUT PASS**
- Drivers need to **stay with their vehicles** at all times through the load out process.

Load-out Procedure

- Completely pack up pit
- **Check in with Pit Admin** once your load out vehicle/s is ready to go
- **provide them with a cell phone number** of the driver or drivers
- Once driver/s receive a **text messaged Load Out Pass** they can proceed to the arena loading area.

FOOD

UCSD LIONTREE ARENA CONCESSIONS OPEN

- Venue operated concessions will be available at the event Friday-Sunday
- Outside food is not allowed in the venue
- Any food can be eaten outside the venue



- Water will be allowed to be brought in during robot load in times on Thursday evening and Friday morning

SAFETY FIRST

SAFETY GLASSES + CLOSED TOE SHOES

SAFETY GLASSES:

- Safety glasses will **not be available to borrow** this year.
- Bring enough safety glasses for every member of your team (students and adults).
- Bring extra safety glasses for and parents or visitors that may be attending with your team.



CLOSED TOE SHOES:

- Remind your team members and any adults/guests that closed toe shoes are required in the pits.

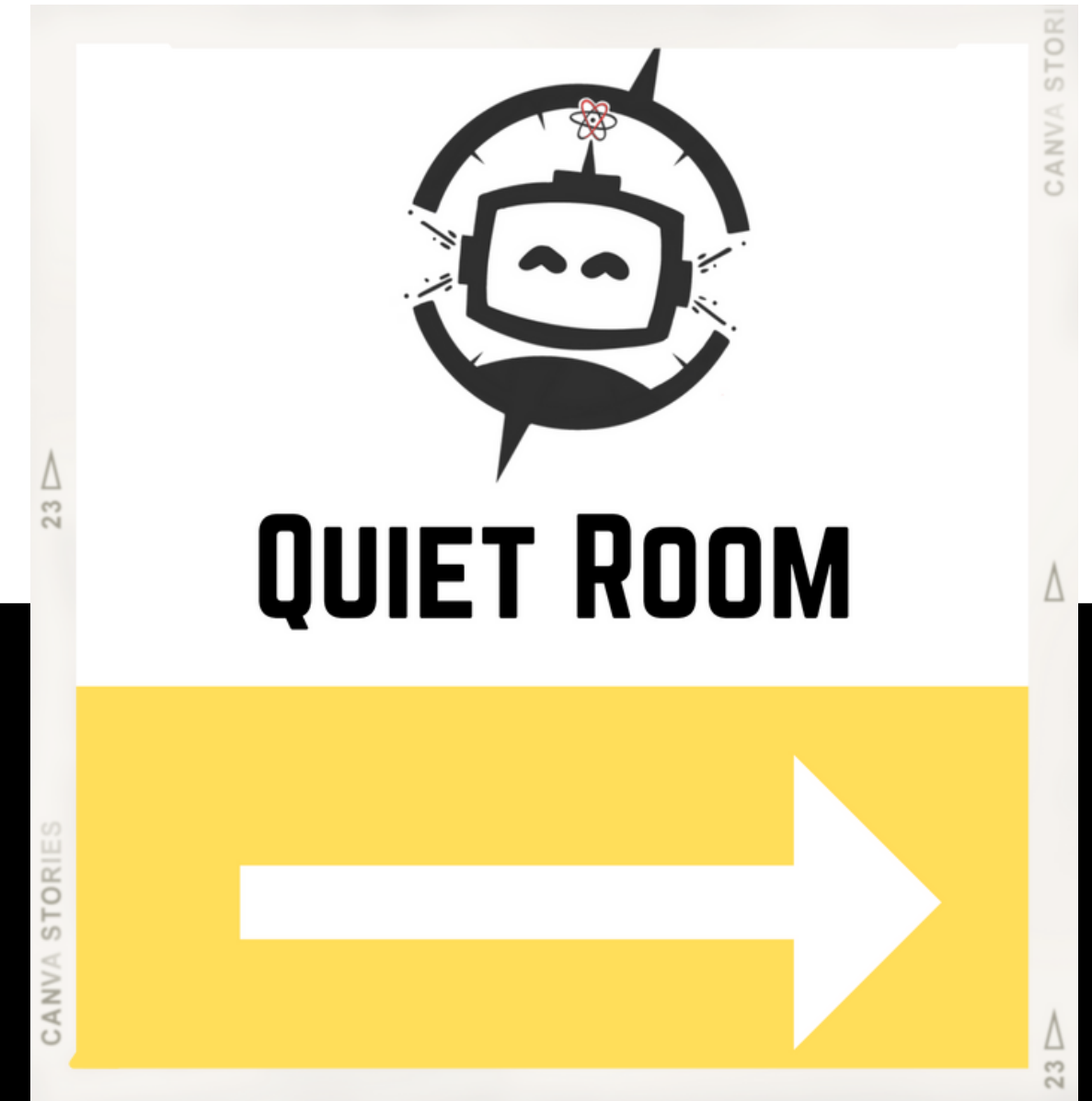
