
How do you participate?

- 1. **Introduce** your Regional Director to a school or group that did not participate in FRC in the 2023-24 season.
- 2. Offer support as necessary to help the new team join the program.
- 3. Mentor the new team during their first 2 years.

Why would you want to do this?

- Recognition as a SuperStarter at all FIRST California FRC Regionals.
- Receive a SuperStarter digital badge and certificate
- Enhancing your Impact Award submission.

FUNDING



In order to grow *FIRST*, we also need to grow financial support in the region:

 - Invite your Regional Director to speak






VOLUNTEERS

Regionals are successful due to volunteers - we need approximately 100 volunteers per Regional.

- Encourage the parents on your team to volunteer (or family, friends, mentors)
- Invite employees at your workplace to volunteer at an FRC Regional.
- **Dollars for Doers:** Many companies offer a corporate giving program that matches your volunteer hours with monetary donations.

VENUES



As we grow *FIRST*, we need to add more events at lower cost venues.

- Let us know about potential venues for Regional Events or Off-Season events
 - Example:
 - Schools that have 2 gyms (1 for field/spectators and 1 for pits)
 - Schools that have 1 gym and another locatoin for pits
 - Other low-cost venues (ex: The Port of Hueneme)

FIRST Code of Conduct


- Exhibit Gracious Professionalism® at all times. Gracious Professionalism is a way of doing things that encourages high-quality work, emphasizes the value of others, and respects individuals and the community. With Gracious Professionalism, fierce competition and mutual gain are not separate notions.
- Ensure the safety of all participants in *FIRST* activities.
- Not engage in any form of bullying, harassment, use of profane or insulting language, or any actual or threatened violence.
- Adhere to all FIRSTYouth Protection Program (YPP) policies.
- Report any unsafe behavior to event or local FIRST leadership.
- Persons who do not comply with this Code of Conduct may be barred from participating in FIRST activities.

FIRST Team Safety meeting

- Conduct a safety meeting at the beginning of the school year/season
- Meeting Key Items :
 - a. Safety Meeting Guidelines
 - b. Safety Requirements
 - c. Boundaries
 - d. Reporting Safety Concerns
 - e. Open Discussion
