



Team Member/Public Access:

Access the UCSD LionTree Arena through the main entrance located off of Ridge Walk pathway, which is easily accessible from the Hopkins parking Structure.

- We have secured a special parking rate
- Only parking in spots labeled of B, S & V
- Must be paid for using the ParkMobile app
- before you arrive



• Overflow parking is available in the Pangea Parking Structure (5-10 min walk to the arena)

OVERSIZED PARKING REGENTS ROAD NORTHEAST LOT

- In UCSD's remote parking lot at the corner of Voigt Dr. and Campus Point Drive
- No oversized or overnight parking is available on campus.
- Parking is free
- The lot is not really walkable from the venue (30 minute walk).
- There is no security







Active Load In Times:

Key Points:

• Thursday, 3/20, 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM • Friday, 3/21, 7:45 AM to 8:30 AM

• Teams must queue in a remote area

prior to being allowed into the arena loading area.

• Large trailers are discouraged. The


arena loading area is very tight.



Load-in Procedure:

- Drive to the queue area located at Northpoint Lane parking loop (lot P359)
- Check in with volunteers
- Driver must stay with vehicle at all times throughout the load-in process
- Once at the front of the line, a volunteer will allow you to depart to the arena loading area by providing you a LOADING PASS
- Drive to Arena Loading Area at the arena
- Check in with Volunteer upon arrival
- Unload vehicle
- Depart the load in area immediately after your vehicle is unloaded

HOURS TO ARRIVE IN THE QUEUE AREA • Thursday, 3/20: 4:00pm - 7:45pm • Friday, 3/21: 7:15am – 8:15am



Key Points

- Team's load out vehicle/s must queue in the remote area prior to being allowed in the arena loading area
- Drivers will be turned away at the arena loading area if they don't have a LOAD OUT PASS • Drivers need to stay with their vehicles at all times through the load out process.

Load-out Procedure

- Completely pack up pit
- Check in with Pit Admin once your load out vehicle/s is ready to go • provide them with a cell phone number of the driver or drivers • Once driver/s receive a text messaged Load Out Pass they can proceed to the arena
- loading area.

LOAD OUT TIME: • Sunday, 3/23, 1:00pm – 6:00pm

There will be no queue area volunteer for load out.



- Outside food is not allowed in the venue
- Concessions will not be available
- Any food can be eaten outside the venue
- No cooking or heating devices allowed on site
- Pop-ups allowed outside, but cannot remain overnight



 Water will be allowed to be brought in during robot load in times on Thursday evening and Friday morning

TRASH & RECYCLING

- We are guests at UCSD and want to be invited back
- Please do your part in managing your trash and recycling
- We will be providing large trash bags for teams' excess trash
- Trash bags can be placed in dumpster in loading area






