

ADVANCEMENT

- Teams will compete and earn points in 2 District Qualifier events in California only.
- Teams will be ranked based on the region they are located in (Northern or Southern California) and advance to one of <u>two</u> State Championships.
- The top 60 teams in each area (North and South) will advance to a State Championship.
- Each State Championship will advance its winning alliance and Cultural Award winners (*FIRST* Impact Award, Engineering Inspiration, and Rookie All-Star) to the *FIRST* Championship.
- The remainder of California's *FIRST* Championship slots will be allocated according to District Points across the state (i.e. with no North/South distinction), following the same allocation process in any other district.







AWARDS - same awards as Regional Events with a few minor tweaks.

- Dean's List Finalist Award is only presented at the District Championship.
 - Each District event will have 1 or 2 State Championship Dean's List Semi-Finalists.
 - Teams will submit their Dean's List Nominees and the student will be assigned to interview at one of their 2 District events.
 - Semi-Finalists will have a second interview at their team's designated State Championship (regardless of whether or not the team is competing, and regardless of where a student qualified).
- The Woodie Flowers Finalist Award is only presented at the State Championship.
 - Nominees are recognized at each District event.
 - The exact number of Woodie Flowers Finalist Awards is to be determined.







AWARDS - same awards as Regional Events with a few minor tweaks.


- Some awards are classified as **Cultural Awards** by FIRST.
 - The three Cultural Awards are the <u>FIRST Impact Award</u>, <u>Engineering Inspiration Award</u>, and <u>Rookie All-Star Award</u>.
 - Teams who win the <u>FIRST Impact Award</u> at a District Qualifier event will automatically qualify to compete for the award and to compete with their robot at the State Championship.
 - Teams who win <u>Engineering Inspiration</u> or <u>Rookie All-Star</u> will qualify to compete for <u>that award</u>
 <u>only</u>, unless they earn enough points to qualify to compete with their robot.
 - Teams who do not qualify with their robot may be interviewed in-person at their State
 Championship or may be offered a remote interview.

EVENT PREFERENCES

- Each registered team gets a random number from 1 to x (number of teams)
- For first round, system starts with preferencing team 1, then 2, ...
- Reverse order for round 2



FIRST Code of Conduct

- Exhibit Gracious Professionalism® at all times. Gracious Professionalism is a way of doing things that encourages high-quality work, emphasizes the value of others, and respects individuals and the community. With Gracious Professionalism, fierce competition and mutual gain are not separate notions.
- Ensure the safety of all participants in FIRST activities.
- Not engage in any form of bullying, harassment, use of profane or insulting language, or any actual or threatened violence.
- Adhere to all FIRSTYouth Protection Program (YPP) policies.
- Report any unsafe behavior to event or local FIRST leadership.
- Persons who do not comply with this Code of Conduct may be barred from participating in FIRST activities.

- Conduct a safety meeting at the beginning of the school year/season
- Meeting Key Items :
 - a. Safety Meeting Guidelines
 - b. Safety Requirements
 - c. Boundaries
 - d. Reporting Safety Concerns
 - e. Open Discussion





AB 506

AB506 require volunteers working with youth 16+ hrs/month or 32+ hrs/year to complete:


- 1. Livescan Fingerprint Check (one-time)
- 2. Mandated Reporter Training (one-time, free online)

These are in addition to FIRST's background check & YPP training.

Instructions to complete AB506 screening

Lead Coach 1 & 2 must complete before event preference.

Allow 2–3 weeks for processing.

GRANTS & REGRANTING

APPLY FOR GRANTS!

- Do not pay registration if your team is waiting for grants/donations to come into FIRST
- <u>FIRST will not will not refund money</u> paid if restricted grants come in after payment
- Unrestricted funds in your team's FIRST account can be used to pay registrations or regranted to your team





How do you participate?

- 1. **Introduce** your Regional Director to a school or group that did not participate in FRC in the 2024-25 season.
- 2. **Offer support** as necessary to help the new team join the program.
- 3. Mentor the new team during their first 2 years.

Why would you want to do this?

VOLUNTEERS






