















What is Design Thinking?

- Design Thinking helps us understand the people we are designing for
- A solution-based approach to solving problems
- Way of thinking and working, and a collection of hands-on methods
- An iterative process in which we seek to understand the user, challenge assumptions, and redefine problems to identify alternative strategies and solutions that might not be instantly apparent

Design Thinking – Empathy

- Foundation of <u>human-centered</u> design.
- To empathize, you must **Observe**, **Engage** and **Immerse**
- What-How-Why tool to develop insightful interview questions

Design Thinking – Define

- Translate Empathy findings into <u>compelling needs</u> & scope a <u>specific challenge</u>
- To define you, Focus, Understand and Develop
- Explicitly express a Problem Statement from your user's Point Of View

Strategize & Navigate

- Innovation Challenge info and Q&A
- Intellectual Property and Provisional Patent 1-year timeline from going public
